We are finding that more parents are reporting impetigo (school sores) to the Kura. Although whānau are seeking treatment prior to their child returning, we are asking all whanau to please check your child for skin rashes as often when left untreated they can cause serious skin damage.

The Regional Public Health Nurse is available for appointments at the Kura every Tuesday mornings. If you have an urgent concern please see your doctor.
