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Kia whai korōria ki tō tātou Matua-nui-i-te rangi, kia hora tōna marino ki runga i te mata o te whenua, he whakaaro pai ki a tātou katoa. Tēnei hoki te mihi atu ki a koutou i ngā mate o te wā. Ko ō tātou mate ērā. Tuatahi rā, kei te mihi atu ki te whānau Taurima. Ki te whānau hoki o Whāea Meranea, me kī rā rātou katoa kua pā mai nei ki te ringa kaha o aituā. Otirā, ki ō tātou mate huhua o te wā, kei ngā marae maha huri noa i te motu. Mauria mai rātou kia tangihia, kia mihia. E whakatau ai te kōrero; rātou ki a rātou, tātou ki a tātou i roto i te wā nei.
