On Friday 28th Pipiri, a kanikani for all kura tuatahi and Te Puawaitanga non-kapa haka student, will be held in the hall. The kanikani will start at 6pm and finishes at 8.30pm. Entry is by gold coin. These funds will be donated to the rebuild of Taputeranga Marae.

The theme for the kanikani is 'Ngā whetu!' Tamariki are encouraged to wear kakahū piataata (shining clothes) to represent ngā whetū.

There will be a dance competition amongst Pou and a variety of other competitions throughout the evening.

All snacks are to be **pre-ordered** by returning the bottom of this form. There will be no option to purchase food on the night. Orders need to be to the tari by Thursday 27th Pipiri.

All students must return home after kura and return no earlier than 6pm, and must be collected before 8.30pm. Parents are welcome to stay. Students will only be released to parents in the hall.
