Te Puawaitanga - Kura Pō

Students driving to kura

All buses will depart from the arena at 2.15pm to return to kura - the afternoon bus will run as normal.

- Students will need to bring a packed lunch, snacks and a drink bottle, there will be no lunch orders on this day.
