Porirua Guardians Programme

Yesterday three students Music, Raukura P and Fortes celebrated with other young leaders, inspirers and change makers in the Porirua Harbour programme.

This year these students have made several presentations to community groups about - planting at the kura and the Belmont Regional Park, help create a sign alongside local artist Vianney Parata, written rotarota for the Te Awarua o Porirua harbour journal, organised a "Rā kōhi rapihī" where PCC donated gloves and bags for the day, and made tonu to the WCC for funds to help regenerate the ecosystem of koawa of the kura.

As a result of the students work: PCC are donating funds to the kura for the next two years and will be removing the conifer trees in 2021.
