Responses to our survey from last week:

Thank you to all the whānau who responded to our survey last week about the Government School Donations Scheme. Some feedback about the responses to our survey:

- We received a total of 79 responses to our survey, representing 135 tamariki.
- The returns voted 100% for continuing involvement in the School Donations scheme.
- 16/79 responses indicated they did not think a meeting was necessary but they did want more information.
- 3 whānau thought a meeting was preferable.
- 60 of the 79 respondents did not think a meeting was necessary.

Based on this feedback the Board of Trustees has agreed to confirm that our kura chooses to opt into the donations scheme for 2021. More information about the scheme and the use of these funds in our kura will be issued next term.

Shared Kai - to celebrate the end of term 2, we are having Pizza and Chips for our shared kai tomorrow, Thursday 2 July. We ask that each child bring \$2. **Children do not need to bring kai, there will be no hoko kai on that day.**

Kura tuatahi netball:
