- At the end of all performances time will be set for whānau and children to have photos, then all children are to return to the changing area. We will then dismiss children and release them to adults. Children must remain inside the venue throughout all performances until the final karakia.

Whānau are welcome to video and livestream the performances however we just ask that whānau remember these should only be shared with whānau and please don't get in the way of our kaumatua or tamariki seated in the audience.
