4. NCEA Exams 2021

Firstly, congratulations to all our taura for their achievements this year. It hasn't been easy focusing on completing assessments this year but they pushed themselves everyday regardless of the effects of COVID.

In this pānui you will see the days and times of exams. You will see that they are being held at two centres this year, Porirua College and here at the kura. Please ensure your child knows the timetable and is prepared:

1. On the day of your exam, please arrive at kura by 8.50am dressed in Kākāhu ōkawa and wait in the tari for instructions.
2. Collect your admission form from Whāea EveJane before you go to your exam. No form, no entry.
3. Students who are sitting at Porirua College will be transported there and then brought back to kura after their exam. Regardless if you're sitting an exam at kura or Porirua College, you must be on time.
4. Ensure you have your snap lock bag with your pens (no pencils), any medication (asthma pumps), a clear drink bottle

5. Learners Licence Course

Partners Porirua have agreed to hold a two day Learners Licence Course for students on 3 and 4 December. The aim is that students sit their learner licence that same week. To register for this course students need to be at least 16 years of age.

Students will need two items showing proof of identity - NZ Passport or NZ Full Birth Certificate and student ID card (\$10 from the kura). All documents must be originals. There is a \$20.00 fee to join the course.

Students interested in registering should register with Whāea EveJane, proof of identity and payment will be required before 3 December please.
