Kua rere ngā tau e whitu a tā Papa Charlie noho hei kaitiaki i tō tātou kura. Ko ia tērā i taka i te parakuihi, i toha atu te hua rākau, i manaaki i ngā tamariki, ngā taiohi ia te rā. Heoi rā, e kore te kupu maioha e mimiti ki ā rāua, ngā ringa raupā, ngā puna mātauranga i heke mai i Matatua Waka, i a Ngāti Awa iwi.

Swimming Programme
