Ko te whaakaronui ki te wāhi ngaro kia tau mai tōna wairua ātawhai ki runga i tēnā i tēnā o tātou.

COVID update

A reminder to parents and whānau that entrance into the kura must be via the main office door. Parents are to remain in their cars when picking up and dropping off children. Drop off zones are outside the hall and pick up zones are on the court.

Face Masks

Our tamariki and taiohi continue to get used to wearing masks in classrooms. From next week, we ask that parents supply masks for their child/children. We will have a limited supply at kura. Te Puawaitanga students who continually ask for masks - will be charged for these.

Vaccination Clinic at Kura

We have planned 3 vaccination clinics at the kura for all whānau wanting vaccinations from Years 1 to 13 and boosters for adults 18+. Vaka Atafaga Pacific nursing service will be administering these vaccinations: Clinic days are from 1pm to 2.30pm on:

- 25th Feb
- 4th March and
- 13th May

If you would like to attend a clinic please contact the kura to book. We will need to know names and ages of the whānau members you will be bringing. This is for the kura admin booking process only.
All students MUST be accompanied by a parent or adult (18+).

Swimming Programme - Our swimming programme is scheduled to start in week 5 of term 2 for the remainder of the term. All kura tuatahi children will swim at the Cannons Creek pool this year.

Chromebook Charger Check - we will have the last of our school electrical appliances tested this Friday. Students who take their chromebooks home are asked to clearly name and bring their chargers to kura for testing in the morning. Chargers that do not have a 2022 pass sticker will not be able to be placed in the kura power sockets.

Bus Registration - we have 3 school buses that travel to and from Titahi Bay, Takapuwhia and Porirua East. The buses are considered private charters as we advise the route and where possible utilise Metlink bus stops.

We are asking all whānau to re-register to ensure they are aware of the financial commitment and expected behaviour of students.

Current bus registered students will return home with a green form today. Please complete and return this form apopo. Students not re-registered by Friday may be removed from the bus register on Monday.
