COVID UPDATE: Red light level 3

We ask that we all keep monitoring our children for any signs or symptoms throughout this time. Please also consider our students who have tested positive and their privacy.

Hybrid Learning

Kura Tuatahi - In order to ensure children have access to a device, please let us know if your child needs a device while isolating, a kaiako will contact you. Kura tuatahi have posted a short survey on their Seesaw sites.

At this stage - until you are advised - children who are isolating at home can access work from their classroom Seesaw. If you are unable to access this please email their kaiako.

Kura Tuarua - For the remainder of this week students will receive a link for each of their subject areas to link in via zoom if they are at home isolating.

If whānau require pastoral support please let Whaea Evelyn or Whaea Kataraina know, we will add your name to the referral list with our local COVID Response Team.

Vaccination Clinics at Kura - our second of three kura whānau clinics will be held this Friday 4th March from 10am to 12pm.

The clinic is open to all who need their first dose, second dose or eligible adults needing their booster.
