Ka hinga te ao, ka pukea te whenua. He papa haukū i te tini marangai o roimata, o waikamo ka heke nei. Ka hinga te ao, he autā te pō e karanga nei kia hoki a niniwha, a māreikura ki a ia e oki ana i kō. E ko te Moana Nui a Kiwa, te taniwha hurihuri i te whakaaro, ātete i te tika.
